Rules

(USBC Certified)

1. Eligibility: All entrants in the CMUSBC association must be in good standing. Entry into this tournament is open to all CMUSBC senior members age 50 and over, as of the entrants' first set of competition.
2. Handicap will be 100% of 240.
3. Tournament will be in Six age classifications as follows: Super Senior (75 and older); Class "A" (70 thru 74); Class "B" (65 thru 69); Class "C" (60 thru 64); Class "D" (55 thru 59); Class "E" (50 thru 54).
4. Bowlers will bowl six (6) games in two (2) three (3) game blocks. Bowlers will be permitted to enter only once.
5. Prize fees will be returned 100% in each classification.
6. No fees will be returned after entries have been received without approval of the tournament manager. In the event of a returned check, the entrant will be notified and required to submit a money order, cashier check or cash in the amount of the check plus \$20 return check fee.
7. Entering Averages: **(A)** Use highest USBC sanctioned average (based on 21 games) for the previous season to include summer averages. **(B)** Bowlers with no average for the previous season may use the current average for nine (9) games or more as of September 29, 2017. **(C)** Bowler with neither of the above averages will enter with a 240 scratch average. **(D)** Rule 319a, item 2; 319e item 2 and 319c average adjustment will not apply. **(E)** It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/hers average. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if summated average is lower than actual average resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on submitted average if it is higher than actual average. Correction in average can be made up to completion of the first game of the series, or within 48 hours after the completion of a series if the tournament manager, prior to the completion of the first game of the series, has given written consent to the bowler authorizing such extension of time to correct his or hers average. **(F)** Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 month period must report actual score, position and amount won for possible rerating. Failure to comply with either of these provisions shall be cause for forfeit tournament entry fee and prize winnings.
8. Winners must provide verification of age.
9. In the event of a tie for championship, to break the tie, high single game with handicap in the competition will be used.
10. There will be one winner for the Open Division and Women's Division. First place handicap winner in each Division will qualify to have their entry fee reimbursed to the next State Senior Tournament upon receipt of entry
11. Lanes will be assigned or drawn by the tournament manager prior to the starting of the tournament.
12. Ratio of prizes will be 1 for every 10 entries.
13. All USBC rules not covered here will govern.
14. Tournament Dress: Bowlers are required to wear: a collard or mock shirt, dress slacks, jeans (clean with no holes), capri's, shorts/skort/skirts (hem must sit at or below the bowler's fingertips with arms relaxed at their sides) or bowling apparel, appropriately designed Team sponsored T-shirt. Prohibited items are but limited to; sweat pants yoga pants, tank tops, bare midriffs and hats no ordinary T-shirts will be permitted. Headgear permitted if medically approved. Participants deemed in violation will not be allowed to bowl. Determination shall rest with the tournament manager.
